Preamble

First and foremost, we want you and everyone to have as much fun as possible during the WOO Worlds 2022 competition.

We consider ourselves at service to the kite community, and want to enhance this awesome hobby for everyone, connect riders across the globe, and share the love we all feel for kiteboarding.

That said, to keep things fun for everyone, we have to keep one aspect of WOO fair and level, and that is the game we all love to play. Every game and competition needs rules, regulations, and a referee to enforce them. We're very well aware that the referee usually is the least liked individual in the whole arena, so we don't take this responsibility lightly and dedicate a large portion of our time to do as good a job as possible. This document is our shot to inform everyone about the rules and guidelines of the WOO Worlds 2022, and how you can ensure that you play fair. In an ideal world, we never have to put our referee in action to enforce them. We really trust and bet on the fairness and integrity of our community. In case we have to enforce them, we follow clear procedures and guidelines to treat every member of the WOO community equally.

The general [WOO Rules & Guidelines](#) stay valid during the whole WOO Worlds 2022.

Definitions

Competition

In the context of this document, “Competition” refers to the overall WOO Worlds 2022 Competition.

Discipline

In the context of this document, “Discipline” refers to one of the 7 Disciplines (4 Individual Disciplines and 3 Team Challenges) that are part of the WOO Worlds 2022 Competition.

Category

In the context of this document, “Category” refers to one of the 4 Categories that are part of the Highest Jump Discipline of the WOO Worlds 2022 Competition.

Competition Period

In the context of this document, “Competition Period” refers to the time between the start and end date of the WOO Worlds 2022 Competition.

Discipline Period

In the context of this document, “Discipline Period” refers to the time between the start and end date of the respective Discipline.

General Rules

In the context of this document, “General Rules” refers to the WOO Worlds 2022 Rules & Guidelines (*a set of rules that are valid for the entire WOO Worlds 2022 Competition*).

General Team Challenge Rules

In the context of this document, “General Team Challenge Rules” refers to a set of rules that are valid for all Team Challenges in the WOO Worlds 2022 Competition.

Discipline Rules

In the context of this document, “Discipline Rules” refers to a set of rules that are valid for a respective Discipline.

Start Recording

In the context of this document, “Start Recording” refers to the exact time when a WOO session is started.

- For GPS Sessions, it is the time when you start the Freeride/GPS session on your phone or Watch.
- For Big Air Sessions, it is the time when you start recording on your WOO Sensor.
- For sessions with Jumps and GPS, it is the earlier of the two times above.

Stop Recording

In the context of this document, "Stop Recording" refers to the exact time when a WOO session is stopped.

- For GPS Sessions, it is the time when you stop the Freeride/GPS session on your Phone or Watch.
- For Big Air Sessions, it is the time when you record the last jump on your WOO Sensor.
- For sessions with Jumps and GPS, it is the latter of the two times above.

Download Session

In the context of this document, "Download Session" refers to the time a recorded session from a WOO Sensor gets transferred to the WOO App on a mobile phone.

Upload Session

In the context of this document, "Upload Session" refers to the time a recorded session reaches our servers. With good internet connectivity, this is usually a few seconds after you hit "Save" in the WOO App.

WOO App

In the context of this document, "WOO App" refers to the WOO App on a supported mobile phone and the WOO Watch App on a supported Watch. It is only allowed to upload a session of the WOO App account owner to the individual WOO App account. The email address used for the WOO App registration is the email address via which WOO Sports contacts you during the WOO Worlds 2022; please make sure to use a registration email address that gets frequently checked. It is highly recommended to choose an account name in the WOO App which correlates with your real forename and surname for better identification.

Note: The WOO App must always be updated to the latest WOO App version.

WOO Sensor

In the context of this document, "WOO Sensor" refers to all WOO 1.0, WOO 2.0 and WOO 3.0 Sensors. To assure accurate results, recording sessions with the latest available firmware version of the WOO Sensor is mandatory.

WOO Mount

"WOO Mount" refers to all WOO Mounts and WOO Frequent Flyer Mounts produced and sold by WOO Sports or an official WOO Dealer. The WOO Mount must be attached to the twintip according to the official WOO Mounting instructions.

Watch

“Watch” refers to Apple Watch Series 3 or higher, and Garmin Watches that are compatible with the Kite GPS and Kite WOO+GPS Watch apps (requires the Garmin Connect IQ SDK). The Watch must always be updated to the latest WOO Watch App Version.

Valid WOO Worlds Session

In the context of this document, “Valid WOO Worlds Session” refers to a session that fulfills all criteria to be considered for the WOO Worlds 2022, and will hence count towards one or more of the Disciplines. A Valid WOO Worlds Session must fulfill the following criteria:

- Enable the toggle button “Compete in the WOO Worlds 2022”
- The session has to be recorded and uploaded within the Discipline Period.
- The session has to be uploaded at the latest 24hrs after Start Recording.
- Age and Gender have to be set correctly in the user profile.
- The correct spot and board type must be chosen.
- The latest firmware has to be downloaded on your WOO Sensor before the session.

Duplicate Session

In the context of this document; a “Duplicate Session” refers to a Valid WOO Worlds Session uploaded to an individual WOO App account more than once. Note: uploading a Duplicate Session will be considered an attempt of cheating!

Individual

In the context of this document, “Individual” refers to an individual person.

Individual Discipline

In the context of this document, “Individual Discipline” refers to a Discipline where Individuals compete against each other.

Team

In the context of this document, “Team” refers to a group of individuals that are in the same team.

Team Challenge

In the context of this document, “Team Challenge” refers to a Discipline where Teams compete against each other.

Team Score

In the context of this document, “Team Score” refers to the total score of the top 5 team members.

Preliminary Standings

In the context of this document, “Preliminary Standings” refers to a set of preliminary leaderboards on www.leaderboards.wooworlds.com that is subject to change and approval by the WOO Worlds 2022 Organization.

Official Results

In the context of this document, “Official Results” refers to the final and irrevocable announcement of the winners of the Categories and Disciplines of the WOO Worlds 2022 Competition.

Highlights

In short, these are the rules everyone must follow:

1. Don't cheat. ZERO (zip, null, nada, niente, zilch...) tolerance on this one. The extent of disciplinary actions on cheating attempts is up to WOO Sports referees.
2. Only activities on water count, and you can only use kites or wings as propulsion (boats, cars or other non-kite or -wing powered equipment is prohibited).
3. Make sure your profile is set correctly (age, gender) before the WOO Worlds 2022 start.
4. Read and adhere to the Competition timetable (see below).
5. Upload your session
 - Immediately after recording it.
 - Always enable the toggle button “Compete in the WOO Worlds 2022”. This button will be visible in the WOO Sports app while uploading your session between September 16th till October 16th.
 - Additionally, use
 - #drawanything to participate in the “Draw Anything” Discipline.
 - Upload your session at the correct WOO spot and with the correct board type.
 - Upload your session on your own individual WOO account.
 - Changes to your session at a later stage are not allowed.
 - Duplicate sessions are not allowed.
6. The WOO Mount must be attached to the board according to the official WOO Mounting instructions.
7. Watch your tone!
8. Always put safety first, ride hard & have fun!

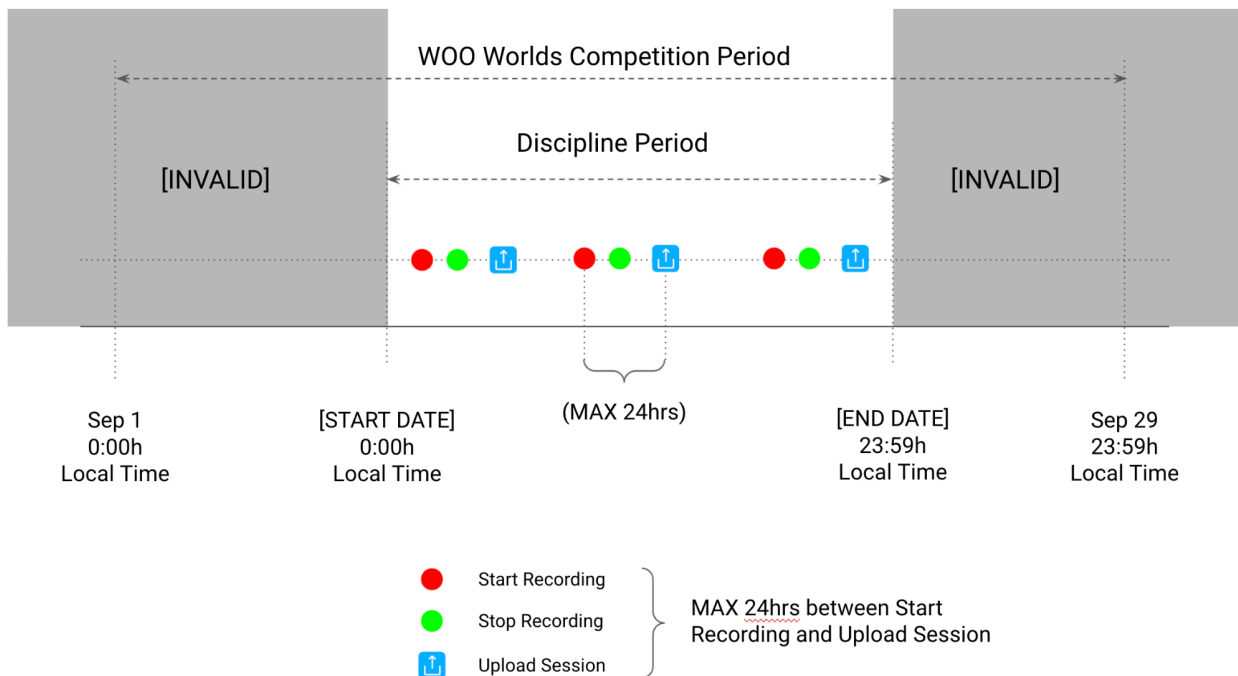

General Rules

The General Rules below are valid for the entire WOO Worlds 2022 competition.

Recording & Uploading Sessions

1. Always enable the toggle button “Compete in the WOO Worlds 2022”. This button will be visible in the WOO Sports app while uploading your session between September 16th till October 16th. Additional hashtags are required for the “Draw Anything” Discipline (#drawanything). See the table in Appendix A, or the respective Discipline rules, for more info.
2. The latest firmware has to be downloaded on your WOO Sensor before the session.
3. A “Valid WOO Worlds Session” cannot be changed after uploading. You cannot add or remove hashtags, change the spot, or change your age/gender.
4. The time of “Start Recording” and “Upload Session” of each session has to be within the Competition Period and within the Discipline Period of the Discipline you want to compete in.
5. Sessions have to be uploaded within 24hrs of the “Start Recording” time. Note that regardless of this rule, the “Upload Session” Time cannot be outside of the Discipline and/or Competition Period. Example:



Terms & Conditions

6. The Terms & Conditions must be accepted to enter the Competition. To accept the Terms & Conditions, enable the toggle button "Compete in the WOO Worlds 2022" while uploading a session during the Competition Period - the app will present you the opportunity to read our Terms & Conditions

Cheating

7. Any attempt to cheat, any wrong usage of the WOO Sensor and/or GPS features, or any attempt to break the General Rules, General Team Challenge Rules or Discipline Rules will get you disqualified from the WOO Worlds 2022 and can lead to a permanent ban on the WOO platform.
8. The WOO Worlds organization has the right to delete specific jumps or sessions if there is reason to believe that there was cheating or wrong use of our product (WOO Sensor) involved. This also includes an incorrect positioning of the WOO Sensor.
9. Knowingly uploading wrong data can be considered an attempt of cheating and penalized accordingly.

Reporting any attempt of cheating or disregarding the rules mentioned referring to the WOO Worlds 2022 competition shall be sent to wooworlds@woosports.com. The message shall include the name of the reporter, the WOO account name of the person not acting according to the (WOO Worlds 2022) WOO Rules & Guidelines, a thorough explanation or a clear picture of the attempt of cheating or disregard of the (WOO Worlds 2022) WOO Rules & Guidelines.

Prerequisites

10. Age and gender must be set correctly before the Competition starts, so before September 16th 2022. Wrong age and/or gender information can be considered an attempt of cheating and can lead to Disciplinary Action.
11. We can ask for your identification. If you are unable or don't want to show us we will disqualify you from the WOO Worlds 2022 and you will not be entitled to the prizes including prize money.

Results

Official Results from the WOO Worlds 2022 Competition with all its Disciplines and Categories will be announced on our social media.

Preliminary standings for all Disciplines are available via the links below. The Preliminary Standings are subject to change and pending approval of the WOO Worlds 2022 Organization.

Contacting Winners

The email address used for the WOO App registration is the email address via WOO Sports gets in contact with you during the WOO Worlds 2022 (feel free to add wooworlds@woosports.com to your address book so our messages won't end up in your spam folder); please make sure to use a registration email address that gets frequently checked. It is highly recommended to choose an account name in the WOO App which correlates with your real forename and surname for better identification so we have the chance to find you on any other platforms in case you won't react to a winner email.

A winner has 2 weeks time from our first message to reply, otherwise, we can't guarantee that the prize will still be available!

2. For the Junior category you need to be 16 years or younger. This means you will participate in the Junior Category if your date of birth is the 17th of September 2005 or later.
3. This Category is only available for twintip boards. Hydrofoils and directionals are unable to take part in this Discipline.
4. The highest jump of your Valid WOO Worlds 2022 Sessions will count in this Category.
5. If you compete in the Junior category, you will only compete in the Junior category. You will be excluded from participating in the Women or Male Category.

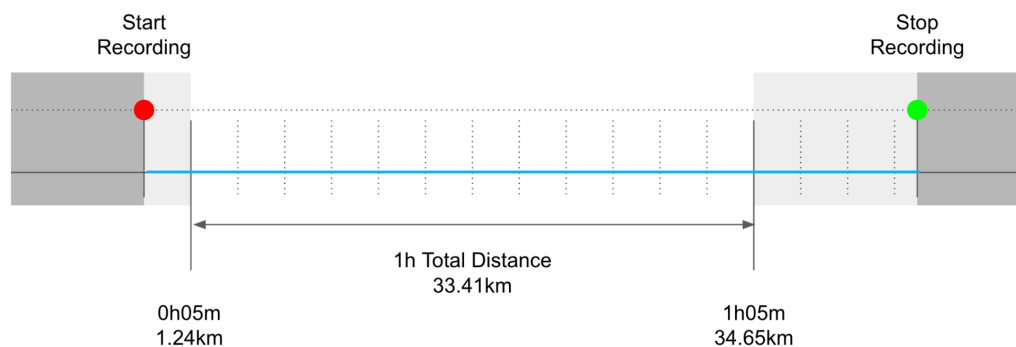

1. In this Discipline, all that counts is purely who can travel the longest distance over water in 1 hour while being powered exclusively by a kite or a wing.
2. To allow you to prepare, will start measuring the 1hr Distance 5 minutes after you Start Recording, and stop measuring 65 minutes after you Start Recording. Any other GPS data is not considered.



3. The attempt must be completed purely by kitesurfing on a twintip, hydrofoil, directional or wing foil.
4. If any part of the session is not over water, or otherwise manipulated, the session will be invalidated, and Disciplinary Action will be taken.

1. Add the hashtag #drawanything in your description when you upload the session.
2. You can be quite creative in the “Draw Anything” Discipline. There are no limitations regarding this, except that it needs to be well visible on the GPS map in the WOO Sports app. This means that it is big enough to see and doesn’t have GPS scribbles crossing it, e.g. from your previous or subsequent up- or downwind kiting.
3. You can draw anything at any time in your session, as long as your previous or afterwards up- or downwind riding GPS scribbles don’t ruin the drawing.
4. The attempt must be completed
 - a. kitesurfing on a twintip, hydrofoil, directional or
 - b. on a wing and a foil.
5. If any part of the session is not on water, or otherwise manipulated, the session will be invalidated, and disciplinary action will be taken.

Team Challenges

Participating in a Team Challenge

Competing in the Team Challenges is very easy.

1. Go to: <https://teams.wooworlds.com>
2. Log in to your WOO account
3. Either accept an invitation if your friend has already invited you to his Team or create your own Team. We recommend having at least 5 Team Members since we take the top 5 score of each Team Member.
4. Choose a Team name.
5. Add your friends to your Team.
6. Click on Create once your members are all added. Your Team is now ready to compete in the WOO Worlds 2022 Team Challenges.

Extra Team Challenge Information

All General Rules apply.

- An Individual can only be a member of one Team. With your Team, you can compete in all three Team Challenges.
- Note that you can create or edit a team until the 15th of September at 23:59. After this the WOO Worlds will start and Teams can't be edited anymore.
- Make sure to have the WOO Worlds toggle button enabled while uploading your session. This button will be visible in the WOO Sports app while uploading your session between September 16th till October 16th.

Available Team Challenges

There are 3 different Team Challenges:

1. Team Total Distance (GPS)
2. Team Total Height (WOO Sensor).
3. Team Max Height (WOO Sensor)

Example 1:

You go out with your Watch and a WOO Sensor and upload your session while enabling the WOO Worlds toggle button. There will be jump data and distance data so your session will count for your Team in all three Team Challenges. Note that it will only count to the Team Challenge that is running at the moment of recording and uploading.

Example 2:

You go out with just your Watch or GPS phone (no WOO Sensor) and upload your session. There will be only distance data (no jump data) so your session will count for your Team in the Team Total Distance Challenge

Example 3:

You go out with just your WOO Sensor (no GPS phone or Watch) and upload your session. There will be only jump data (no distance data) so your session will count for your Team in the Team Total Height Challenge and in the Team Highest Jumps Challenge.
